

## Inspirational Play – Mahasati Anjana - Raises Over \$100,000 for the Center's Building Project

STAFFORD - JVB Preksha Meditation Center's "Mahasati Anjana", a play that depicts the life of the mother of Veer Hanuman was superbly performed at the Stafford Civic Center on January 12 and 13 in front of sold out audiences. More than 1400 people attended the play which was inspired by Samani Akshay Pragyaaji and Vinay Pragyaaji, and masterfully directed by Mr. Hemant Bhavsar and Mr. Ashok Patel.

According to Swatantra Jain, Chairman JVB Preksha Center Houston, the event raised over \$100,000 to help support funds for the JVB Preksha Center Building Project.

The new center will be located on Schiller Road just past Arya Samaj and before Durga Bari society. "The uniqueness of the project is its pyramid shape meditation hall of about 3900 sq. ft. The construction is expected to begin in March of this year, and is scheduled to be completed by the end of the year," Jain said.

Earlier, Alok Jain, Director, and past president JVB, and Master of Ceremony welcoming the audience said that the JVB Preksha Center was a part of the JVB organization in India with H.H. Acharya Mahapragyaaji as its visionary, charismatic, and dynamic leader.

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

But only a few people knew that the source of all these qualities was his mother, Anjana, who in spite of being a princess struggled very hard in bringing up Lord Hanuman. In Jain tradition, Anjana is glorified as "Mahasati", Supreme Be-

ing. Mahasati Anjana is an amalgamation of optimism and struggle of a woman. The play narrates the determination in which she fights against all odds in her life, and still preserves the dignity of moral character. Following the narration, the Samanijis asked the audience to sit straight, fold their hands with eyes closed, and recited Namokar Mahamantra. In the second half of the program, Hasmukh Patel, President of the center, spoke about Preksha Center and its activities. Dr Sulekh Jain, the first President of JVB and founding member, honored Ashok Patel, while Mr. Jugal Malani, Director of JVB, honored Hemant Bhavsar for the excellent direction that both of them provided for the play, with gifts as a token of appreciation for their invaluable time and contributions to the Preksha Center.
