The Jain Network has purchased a spacious building at 64-68 Colindale Avenue, London NW9 5DR near the Colindale tube station on 12th May 2010, for the development as the Jain Centre London to provide facilities for worship and study for all Jains. Our aim is to improve the Spiritual and Physical Quality of Life of Jains and Wider Communities. We have made interim development of the Centre with 4500 sq ft hall, seminar room, offices, temple and necessary ancillary facilities. Our vision is to develop these premises into 30,000 sq ft centre with glimpses of the Indian architecture at its best.

As a part of our educational activities we have planned the establishment of Heritage and Cultural Academy that will promote learning and performances of various activities such as Music, Dance, Drama, Art, Yoga and Meditation.
